

Minutes of the May 10, 2010 RHS Band Parents Association Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Theresa Iannone at 7:35 pm. The list of attendees is included as an attachment.

1. Welcome/President's Report: Theresa Iannone
 - a. Theresa spoke to the Village Council about the national honor received by the Ridgewood music programs and concerns about how reductions in the music program would be likely to seriously affect those programs. There's another meeting on the 17th at which a budget vote will be taken.
 - b. Jeff is ill today but is worried about the marching band recruitment for next year. We may lose a couple of students to Bergen Academy.
 - c. We've been getting good press about the band.
 - d. Cynthia Campo is the new Band Council President.
2. Minutes: Tom Jewell. The minutes of the April 19, 2010 meeting were reviewed, moved and unanimously approved.
3. Band Council Report: Cynthia Campo.
 - a. This Saturday is the car wash, and we need to do well. We need towel and food donations as well as parent volunteers.
 - b. The Coffee House bill came and the Band Association will provide a donation letter when a check is received to pay it.
 - c. Miss D'elia's gift was presented and a bill will be presented. The Band Association will pay up to \$200 above what was donated.
4. Treasurer's Report: Tim Graham.
 - a. Bank balance is about \$30,000 less than last month mostly because of reimbursement and scholarship checks written.
 - b. We deposited \$1259 costume fees. The bank didn't accept all checks that were presented.
 - c. The budget for next year should be approved in June.
 - d. We've been very close to our predicted budget items this year, although fundraising was a bit higher than predicted.
 - e. The unused points credits provide an opportunity for a rainy day fund.
 - f. The written report is attached.
 - g. A motion to approve the report was unanimously approved.
5. Committee Reports
 - a. Marching Band Camp 2010—Inge Spungen
 - i. Chaperones for band camp are needed.
 - b. Uniforms: Cathy Caputo
 - i. Deadline for orders is June 1st.
 - ii. Shaksos were cleaned by Cathy Caputo and Henry Heyzer. Several new ones were found. Six berets were ordered for a nominal fee.
 - iii. Sweatshirts and Jackets from last year are available, so we'll wait to see how many more we need.
 - c. Jazz at Winberie's—Arlene Sarappo, Annalise Marcus and Jaime Frederick
 - i. Theresa Iannone reported that Winberie registrations are 91 for the 6:00 pm and 58 for the 8:30 shows.
 - d. Tunes in June—Debbie Benton and Carol Gyzander
 - i. We need to arrange for lemonade to be served and other needed items.

 - i. Jane Harlin placed the order for the amaryllis plants.
